## Integrated Preschool Program

The Integrated Preschool Program is a language-based, preschool environment offering a wide variety of enriching activities in a nurturing, educational setting. It follows a structured academic preschool curriculum, with a low student-teacher ratio. The classroom can hold a maximum of 15 students - eight children who are peer partners (or role models), and seven children having special needs. Peer partners must be 3 (by Sept 1) to 5 years in age. In order for a child to be accepted as a peer partner in our program, he/she must successfully pass a preschool screening (this screening is provided free of charge by the Williamsburg Public Schools and is available throughout the school year).

## Enrollment Event Schedule

Several events occur in preparation for the Fall start of school.

### Open House

Friday March 5, 2010 9:00am – 11:00am

Families are invited to visit our preschool space, meet the teachers, sign up for a developmental screening and learn about the programs offered.

### Pre-Enrollment Period

March 5 – March 26

Parents are invited to schedule a developmental screening for their child and apply for the fall 2010 session of preschool. First round new applications for this program will be accepted through March 26, 2010. A \$10 non-refundable processing fee must accompany applications.

### Developmental Screening

During Friday mornings in March developmental screening are scheduled. A developmental screening is required prior to acceptance into our program. Call 268-8421 to set up a screening appointment.

**Registration:** Upon being notified that your child has been accepted into the program, parents may finish registration for the Fall 2010 session of our program by completing a registration packet and submitting ASAP
