Our Full Day Preschool is a place where children feel they belong and have a sense of community. We focus on each child's physical, social, emotional, & intellectual development.

The program is designed with 4 mornings of program and 3 or 4 afternoons of program per week (Note Thursday is the extra afternoon). All of our Lead Teachers are school district staff with a minimum of a bachelor's degree and course work in early childhood education and child development.

Enrollment Event Schedule

Several events occur in preparation for the Fall start of school.

Open House

Friday March 5, 2010 9:00am – 11:00am

Families are invited to visit our preschool space, meet the teachers, sign up for a developmental screening and learn about the programs offered.

Pre-Enrollment Period

March 5 – March 26

Parents are invited to schedule a developmental screening for their child and apply for the fall 2010 session of preschool. First round new applications for this program will be accepted through March 26, 2010. Applications will continue to be accepted on a rolling basis until the program is at capacity. A \$10 non-refundable processing fee must accompany applications.

Developmental Screening

A developmental screening is required prior to acceptance into our program. Call 268-8421 to set up a screening appointment.

Registration: Upon being notified that your child has been accepted into the program, parents may finish registration for the Fall 2010 session of our program by completing a registration packet and submitting ASAP
